 - The Sportsmen Judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The Sportsmen exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
 - The Sportsmen exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The Sportsmen respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
 - Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
 - Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
