

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

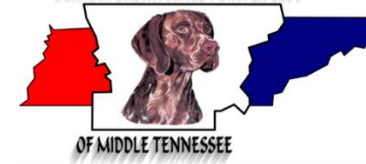

Notice To Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes may **not** run in a higher height division.
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$5 processing fee per run **with a certificate from a veterinarian**.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs**. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean for future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee as assessed by the bank to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- Concessions may or may not be available on site. Plan accordingly.
- **The show site will be available to exhibitors for set up on Thursday as outlined in the Notice to all exhibitors.**
- RVs may come any time on Thursday. Spaces are on a first come basis.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form includes a spot to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running, either by the judge or record or by a VMO or AKC rep if present.

Directions to MTSU Arena

From I-24: Exit 78 (Franklin/96 and Lebanon)- exit the interstate and head toward Murfreesboro (east). You are on Old Fort Parkway; this will become Memorial Blvd/Hwy 231, go until you get to the intersection of Memorial and Clark Blvd. (BP gas and U-Haul on corner). Turn right on Middle Tenn Blvd, go to the intersection of Greenland Dr. and turn left. Parking in front of the arena is on the right past the 2nd traffic light.

From I-40: From west or east take the Lebanon exit for Highway 231 and head south toward Murfreesboro (from Nashville turn right, from Knoxville turn left). This is Memorial Blvd when you get into Murfreesboro. Go to the intersection of Memorial and Middle Tenn Blvd and turn left. Go to Greenland Dr. and turn left. Parking in front of the arena is on the right past the 2nd traffic light.

Double Q Ribbons will be offered, as will special MX and MXJ, Premier Titling, PAX, MACH, PACH, and Grand Champion ribbons.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners™ program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

GSPCMTN COVID GUIDELINES

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and even death. According to the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and those with pre-existing conditions are exceptionally vulnerable. By entering this trial, you voluntarily assume all risks related to COVID-19 exposure. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the following rules will be in place during our trial. These rules will be in effect from the Wednesday setup and continue through all 4 days of the trial including the tear down on Sunday. While we are doing the best we can to make this event as safe as possible, there may still be risk of infection/exposure that we don't know about or cannot control. If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules, then please do not enter our trial. Additional rules and regulations are based on recommendations from both the CDC and the AKC.

Masks – Masks will be required to be worn over the nose and mouth at all times while in the building. Please bring at least one mask with you for your personal use. The only exceptions will be while you are in the ring running your dog. You may put the mask in your pocket as you step to the line with your dog and put it back on as soon as you are done with the run. Our judges will be wearing masks while in the ring and ask that if exhibitors need to talk to them, PLEASE **WEAR** your mask. Masks need **NOT** be worn when outside, but again, please apply 6ft social distancing at all times.

Illness – IF YOU ARE ILL, DO PLEASE NOT COME! If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days – PLEASE DO NOT COME! Exhibitors – We are limiting this trial to exhibitors only. The general public will not be allowed to watch, in an effort to limit the total number of people onsite. Should you or an immediate family member be diagnosed with COVID-19 after the closing date of our trial, your entry payment will be reimbursed MINUS a \$5 administration fee.

Crating – Please allow 6 feet between crating areas. If you have more than one crate, please try to consolidate your crating area as much as possible to allow for more space between people. If a member of the trial committee asks you to move your setup, please do so immediately. Crating set up and spacing will be an individual responsibility. PLEASE be considerate to your fellow competitors and respect them as you would wish to be yourself. If the Committee members see "crating encroachment" you will be asked to move.

Treat tables – In order to limit the number of folks congregating around the rings, we will ask you to come down to run 4-5 dogs before your turn. If you place treats on the treat table, please remove them right after your run. We will be cleaning off these tables regularly.

Ringside - Our goal is to **ONLY** have the next dog on line and 3 more teams with 6ft spacing ringside. Please wait maintaining social distance by the practice jumps until called. Entry to the arena floor will be from the practice jumps entrance ONLY. The exit gates from each ring will be at the end closest to the seating area. Please return to your crating area using the opening by the seating and the stairs signed "UP".

Personal Hygiene - Please wash your hands frequently. If possible bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer with you. We will endeavor to have larger bottles available for competitors to refill their own bottles if necessary. Hand sanitizer will be at each of the Scribe/Timer tables and also at the ribbon tables.

Concessions – Concessions will not be available at this trial. We will be providing worker water. It will be in pre-opened plastic wrap so please only take one bottle at a time. There are a variety of fast food restaurants within a short driving distance of the trial site.

Leashes - If possible, please think about using a light weight leash that you can either put in your pocket or tie around your body.

Walkthroughs – We will be limiting the size of walkthroughs. The final confirmation letter will have an approximate time range, but this may change. Please pay attention to any changes that are announced.

Ribbons - We plan on having three tables set up. One for Master/Ex/Premier; one for Open and one for Nov (with the associated FAST classes). T2B stickers will be placed on the Nov Table. Stickers and a variety of ribbons will also be on each table. Ribbons and stickers will still be on a "self serve" basis, but there will be "Xs" on the floor to indicate 6ft spacing. Again PLEASE be respectful of social distancing.

Trial Secretary and her Team - Please again respect social distancing. A 6ft mark will be placed on the floor.

MACH/PACH parties – Unfortunately, for everyone's safety, there will be no MACH/PACH or other celebratory events at this trial. There will not be a central communal table or pens available for MACH/PACH bars to be signed.

Doors – We will mark doors as "In" or "Out" wherever possible. This is to reduce cross-traffic. Please follow the instructions on these signs.

Stairs - will be marked "up" and "Down"

Changes to rules – We may make changes to these rules prior to the start of the trial. BE SURE to read your confirmation letter to see what changes have been instated. Again, we realize these are changes to activities and habits we have had for a long time. However, in order to hold this trial, these are the compromises we must make, based on information from the CDC and following consultation with the AKC. Please be aware that infractions of these rules will be dealt with according to AKC regulations, up to and including requiring you to leave the trial site and bench committee hearings.

With all these additional requirements, we still hope that you and your dog will have fun getting back to running agility. Stepping into the ring, it will just be you and your dog and enjoying the thrill our sport offers us. Obviously, it is not as it used to be, but hopefully, with all of us taking individual responsibility for our own actions we will have a safe and enjoyable trial.
